

Reserving Cemetery Plots Sharon Methodist Church

Types of Burial Plots

Choosing a burial plot is an important part of the funeral planning process, and there are several options offered to fit your family's needs. There is no cost for purchasing cemetery plots for members of Sharon Methodist Church. There will be a reduced cost for non-member's families buried in reserved family plots. To reserve a burial plot for a non-member spouse or family member, these plots must be paid in full to be reserved.

Perpetual Care

There is a one-time fee for all members and non-members for the care and upkeep of the cemetery. This is to include mowing, grounds maintenance, upkeep of the roads and pathways as well as miscellaneous expenses for the care of the grounds. During the time of internment there will be a one-time \$250 fee to all members to cover perpetual care for each burial site. This fee can be paid in advance or at the time of burial. Non-members perpetual care fee is included in the initial cost as listed below.

Reserving Plots

Each Sharon Methodist Member may reserve two burial plots at no charge per person for * immediate family. These burial sites are at no charge for children under 21 of Sharon Methodist Members. Any non-member family will be charged at a reduced rate per pricing schedule. Each burial site will be kept on reserve if the membership is current. Non-members will be required to purchase the burial site to keep the space available. In the event a current member changes membership, the site is no longer kept on reserve. Each person is required to complete a Cemetery Reservation Form for every burial plot reserved. Payment for a reserved burial plot is non-refundable. It is the responsibility of the family for upkeep and repair of headstones.
